Once the limit has been reached in either the Open or the Utility class, the UDX class will be considered closed and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety.

**PUDX Class:** When entries are limited in the Preferred Open and/or Preferred Utility classes, a club must designate a PUDX class in the premium list. Dogs entered in this class would be entered in both Preferred Open and Preferred Utility, and the combined entry fee for these two classes must be paid. Once the limit has been reached in either the Open or the Utility class, the PUDX class will be considered closed and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety.

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in the premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.

## **Notice to Exhibitors**

Entries close at Noon on October 04, 2017

Fax, Email or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form or photocopy of an entry form without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not valid. Express Mail entries must be clearly marked. NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED. Entries will be returned to sender if no one is present to sign for receipt of the express mail.

**ALL ENTRIES MUST BE LEGIBLE AND FILLED OUT COMPLETELY, MUST INCLUDE AKC AGREEMENT PAGE AND JUMP HEIGHT IF ENTERED IN A CLASS THAT HAS JUMPS OR THEY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

ENTRIES ARE LIMITED and will be taken on first come first served basis, (so get your entries in early). Regular Class entries, including UDX class will be given first priority followed by the Alternative Titling Classes followed by the Optional Titling Classes, followed by the Non-Regular Classes.

Crating Area is limited, X-pens and personal floor mats will not be permitted at the trial site. If needed upstairs crating will be made available. Exhibitor's chair's will only be allowed if space permits.

**Crate setup can begin one hour before the start of the trial.**

Fire aisles MUST be kept clear at all times.

No unentered dogs is permitted or allowed on the site.

No Strollers of any kind due to aisle space in building.

Dogs should be present at least one half hour before they are to be judged. The owner or handler is solely responsible for having their dog at ringside when it is due in the ring. Dog not required for further judging may be excused.

2- Day Trial Catalogs in hard copy will be available on the day of the trial for \$5.00 per catalog.

Food concession will be on the premises.

## **REMINDER**

Obedience Entries Fees: Includes \$0.50 for AKC event recording fee and a \$3.00 event service fee for the first entry and a \$3.00 event service fee for each additional entry of the same dog each day. Entry fees are \$26.00 for the first entry each day regular class and \$19.00 for each additional entry of the same dog, same day (AKC Dog Show Rules Chapter 11, Section 2).

Rally Entries Fees: Includes \$3.50 for AKC event recording fee for the first entry and a \$3.00 event service fee for each additional entry of the same dog each day. Entry fees are \$26.00 for the first entry each day regular class and \$19.00 for each additional entry of the same dog, same day (AKC Dog Show Rules Chapter 1, Section 4).

Non-Regular Entries Fees: AKC event fees are not assessed. Entry fee is \$19.00 for each entry, regardless of the number of non-regular entries per dog.

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED IN THE EVENT A DOG IS ABSENT, DISQUALIFIED, OR EXCUSED BY THE JUDGE OR VETERINARIAN, OR BARRED FROM COMPETITION BY THE TRIAL COMMITTEE. IF RIOTS, CIVIL DISTURBANCES, OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE CLUB MAKES IT IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR COMPLETE THE TRIAL, NO REFUND OF ENTRY FEES WILL BE GRANTED.

Bitches that come into season, after the closing date of the entries, may have the entry fee returned less \$5.00 – upon written request from the owner or handler on or before date of trial.

## Directions to the Trial Site

**From I-4:** Take Exit 27 (Polk County Parkway – Highway 570) to the first exit (Airport Road) approximately three miles. Turn right onto Airport Road, go to the second light (Drane Field Road) and turn left. Then stay on Drane Field Road to Century Boulevard, which will be the second street on the left (across from the firehouse station). Turn into the industrial complex, then use the third driveway on the left. The IPOC building is straight ahead.

**From Highway 60:** Take Highway 60 to County Line Road. Go approximately 5 miles to Drane Field Road and turn right. Travel approximately three miles to Century Boulevard and turn left. Then follow the directions above.

**RV Parking:** 5 slots on site (4 with 30 amps/water + 1 with 110/20 amps/water) for \$20.00/night. A second electrical outlet can be provided for an additional \$10.00. Limited dry camping will be permitted at the trial site for \$5.00/ night. Reservations are required – Please email [toipocts@gmail.com](mailto:toipocts@gmail.com) reserve your site, please include the RV size and if you want dry or power.
