DIRECTIONS

From Interstate 4: Exit 27 – Polk Parkway. Take Polk Parkway to first exit (Exit 3), 25-cent toll (EXACT CHANGE), right on Airport Road. Go 1 mile to 2nd traffic light, left on Drane Field Road, 4/10 mile to Century Boulevard, turn left (across from airport – Renna Enterprises on corner), left at 4th driveway into warehouse complex, go to back building. IPOC Dog Training sign on building.

From Highway 60 (Bartow): US 98 North to Polk Parkway West. Exit at Waring Road, left at the light, go under Parkway to 2nd traffic light. Turn right on Drane Field Road, go about 1 mile, turn right on Century Boulevard (Renna Enterprises on corner), left at 4th drive into warehouse complex, go to back building. IPOC Dog Training sign on building.

From Highway 60 (Brandon): Left (North) on County Line Road at the Polk/Hillsboro boundary between Mulberry and Plant City. About 5 miles, turn right on Drane Field Road, about 2 4/10 miles turn left on Century Boulevard (across from airport – Renna Enterprises on corner), left at 4th drive into warehouse complex, go to back building. IPOC Dog Training sign on building.

AWARDS

First through fourth place will receive placement ribbons. Qualifying scores will also receive ribbons. High in Trial and High Scoring Junior Handler will receive a rosette and a gift item.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Your dog's height must be written on your entry form. Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. The judge reserves the right to measure dogs entered in the trials. Dogs must run in the correct height division.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

Course familiarization will allow each dog entered in A classes to attempt each obstacle, one time, on lead (no slip leads), prior to the start of the judging.

There will be a limit of 200 runs (total combined) per day.
4 Trials – 2 Days

ENTRY FEES

1 class - \$20, 2nd class in same trial - \$10, 3rd class- \$5

DISCOUNTED ENTRY: Enter all 4 trials (one dog in one class) for a total of 4 classes - \$75; one dog in 2 classes for a total of 8 classes-\$110; one dog in 3 classes for a total of 12 runs-\$125

Bitches coming in season after entries close may have entry fees refunded, **less \$5**, provided the Trial Secretary receives notification, **in writing/email**, by the day before the trial. No other refunds will occur after closing date.

NOTICE: These trials will be conducted according the Official UKC Rules and Regulations. Dogs must be registered with the UKC in order to participate. Registration forms are available from the UKC (www.ukcdogs.org). Mixed breeds are welcome in the UKC. Official UKC Rules and Regulations are available from the UKC.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION: These trials will be held indoors in an air-conditioned facility, fully matted and gated. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or the trial is cancelled because of storms, hurricanes, or conditions injurious to our exhibitors and spectators. **NO X-PENS.** No pinch collars allowed in the building. Please leave the grounds in the condition you found them. Dogs cannot be left in the building overnight, but you may leave your crates and chairs. No smoking allowed in the building. Children must be supervised at all times. Park in designated areas and please respect other tenants' space in the complex.

IMPORTANT: Dogs not in the ring must be on leash or crated at all times. Handlers are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. There is a fenced potty area available. Handlers in violation of this policy may be excused by the Trial Committee without benefit of refund.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Incomplete Entry Forms will be returned. It is your responsibility to provide complete and correct information. Failure to do so may result in titles and points being withheld by the UKC.

Your dog's height must appear on the Entry Form.

Your entry must specify whether your dog is entered in the A or B class for both AG I and AG II.

Your dog's UKC registration number must appear on the Entry Form. If the number is pending, write "pending", and it is your responsibility to provide the registration number to the Trial Secretary prior to running your dog.

Agility II A (AG II-A) is open to dogs with no AG II title.

Agility II B (AG II-B) is open to all dogs.

All points toward United Agility Champion Title (U-ACH) must be earned from the Agility I B and Agility II B classes.

Pursuant to UKC Rules and Regulations, dogs may enter both Agility I and Agility II, but the U-AG II titles will not be awarded until the requirements for U-AG I are completed. Dogs must have earned the U-ACH title to enter the Agility III class.

- We want you to keep the points earned at UKC Licensed events.**
Important things to remember:
 - Dog not UKC registered? Apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) online at www.ukcdogs.com or call the Dog Events Department at (269) 343-9020. (TL fees are non-refundable, non-transferable and do not apply to the cost of permanent registration.)
 - All dogs entering UKC events must be permanently registered, have a valid Temporary Listing Number, or a Performance Listing/ Limited Privilege number.**
 - All entry forms must be completed and signed. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form may invalidate your wins.
